

OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT RULES 2010

RULES: Interpretation of these rules shall be exclusively to the tournament committee. The decision of the officials shall be final.

PARTICIPANTS & ELIGIBILITY: At least one firefighter per boat. 2 person teams. *With a maximum of 30 teams.*

LEGAL FISH: Any Game Fish and Pan fish in season will be used for this tournament. All legal size limit and total number of fish will follow the State of Michigan 2010 Fishing Guidelines. *No Pan fish less than 5 inches will be weighed in.*

SCORING: Tournament standing will be determined by pounds and oz's for each type of game fish which the *team* will bring to the weigh in. Pan fish will be weighed by total weight. Only the legal number of fish in your possession by state law will be weighed in.

BIG FISH: Big fish category will be weighed in by each participant with any legal game fish.

TIES: Any ties will be broken by the weight of the largest fish and then total number of fish.

OFFICIAL CHECK IN:

You must check in with tournament officials prior to the tournament meeting. Check in time will start 1-½ hours prior to the tournament. At this time you will receive your start number. And your boat will be checked for proper safety equipment.

Everyone must check in at the end of the tournament. **Everyone** must check in even if you catch no fish.

OFFICAL CHECKPOINT: The boat launch will be the official checkpoint for checkout and check-in. Tournament officials will have no responsibility for finding missing teams.

SAFTEY: Safe boating conduct must be observed at all times by all tournament competitors. Each competitor is required to follow the 2010 State of Michigan Boating Rules and Regulations and U.S. Coast Guard Boating safety rules.

BOAT & MOTOR: Every boat must have all required safety equipment (i.e. Flares, Life Jacket, Oars, etc.)

FISHING LICENSE/ REGULATIONS: Must follow the State of Michigan 2010 fishing rules and regulations.

BOAT IDENTIFICATION: Each boat will be given an identification number and shall remain on your boat until end of tournament.

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Will not be allowed during the tournament.

TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT: All fish must be caught using rod and reel. Each competitor may use only one rod and reel at a time.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations must be made seven days prior to tournament date. Cancellations after that period will result in forfeit of all monies.

I believe I am physically fit for the event.
